

Humboldt Chapter of Democratic Socialists of America Affiliation Agreements Resolution

Whereas, the 2025 DSA Convention passed the Democracy Commission omnibus, including [CB01](#) and [CR01](#);

Whereas, chapters are required to maintain compliance with the Chapter Agreement within the omnibus to maintain good standing;

Whereas, the following resolved clauses are intended to fulfill the requirements set forth for chapters to have in the Chapter Agreement;

Be it therefore resolved that Humboldt DSA shall be bound by Chapter Agreements adopted by the National Convention, and the following clauses will be adopted as standing rules;

Be it further resolved that Humboldt DSA affirms that members have the freedom to organize for shared political perspectives and take part in DSA's democratic processes towards that end. Members of Humboldt DSA may organize to change Humboldt DSA and DSA's policies and program and may openly critique them, while accepting majority decisions as legitimate.

Be it further resolved that a synchronous General Meeting or Convention open to all members is the highest decision making body within Humboldt DSA

Be it further resolved that the Humboldt DSA shall hold at least one decision-making body on an annual basis, ran under [Robert's Rules or other Parliamentary Authority in chapter bylaws] that are open to all members in good standing

Be it further resolved that no candidate will be involved in the administration of their own election;

Be it further resolved that in future elections for chapter officers or national delegates, all VOTERS and CANDIDATES in said elections must be a member in good standing of National DSA THIRTY (30) days PRIOR to the election, in order to participate;

Be it further resolved that Humboldt DSA shall report the results of elections for officers and executive committee members, and of officers or executive committee members that have resigned or been removed within 30 days of any elections, appointments or changes

Be it further resolved that [CHAPTER NAME]'s code of conduct and [CHAPTER NAME]'s Harassment and Grievance Policy does not contradict the [Unified Grievance Policy for National DSA](#), nor the [National Code of Conduct](#), the [Meeting Code of Conduct](#). It is understood that these expectations of conduct also apply to how members act within online spaces;

Be it finally resolved that Humboldt DSA has a Discord Server where members can communicate with each other directly;
